

Judges don't bite ... and SAR's Cinco de Mayo Concours judges have a reputation of being more helpful than critical. We want your experience to be positive and enjoyable. Most of all, we want you to participate. Concours/Exterior & Interior Score Only (7 May)	130 Points
Cinco Volunteer	15 Points
Bonus for the same Porsche in Concours & Autocross	5 Points
Total Possible Points	200 Points

All PCA-SAR members will be automatically entered by registering for the Concours and Autocross. Final scoring will not take place until after the Concours and Autocross are completed and results are posted on the PCA-SAR website and or Facebook page. Score sheets will be reviewed at the May board meeting prior to award announcement at the June Membership Meeting. Winners will be awarded a PCA-SAR gift certificate for a future event.

It is not too early to start improving your autocross skills or to begin cleaning your Porsche for the concours.
