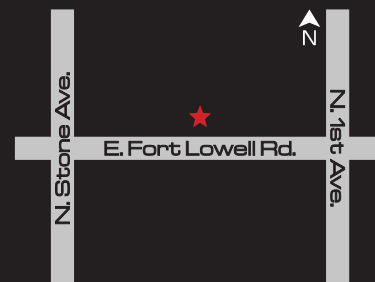

I am sure you understand the driving force behind these changes and hope you will step up to help keep these vital communication tools moving forward.

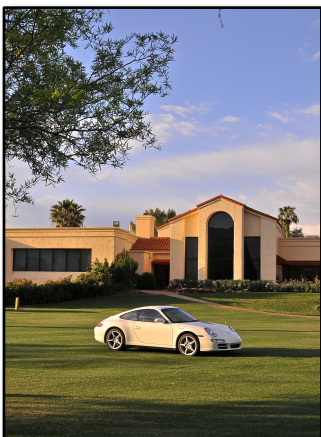

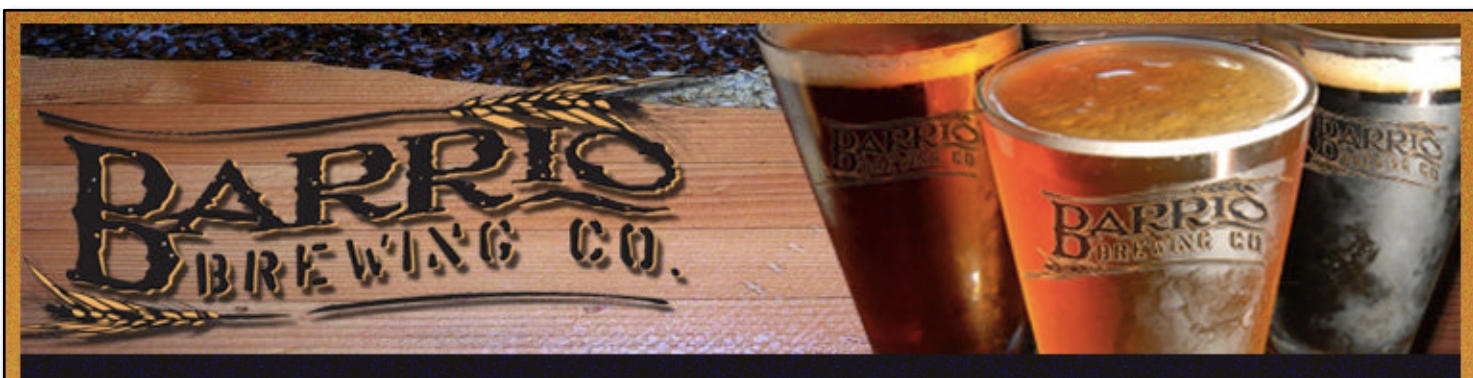

Concours/Exterior & Interior Score Only (7 May)	130 Points
Cinco Volunteer	15 Points
Bonus for the same Porsche in Concours & Autocross	5 Points
<b>Total Possible Points</b>	<b>200 Points</b>

All PCA-SAR members will be automatically entered by registering for the Concours and Autocross. Final scoring will not take place until after the Concours and Autocross are completed and results are posted on the PCA-SAR website and/or Facebook page. Score sheets will be reviewed at the May board meeting prior to award announcement at the June Membership Meeting. Winners will be awarded a PCA-SAR gift certificate for a future event.

It is not too early to start improving your autocross skills or to begin cleaning your Porsche for the Concours.
