From the President



The 2018 Cinco de Mayo Enthusiast Award

It is time to start preparing for the 2018 Cinco de Mayo Enthusiast Contest with the first event, Cinco Autocross taking place on Sunday, April 29. The final competition events will take place at the Concours d'Elegance on May 5. The purpose of the Award is to promote individual club member participation in the two main Cinco de Mayo events (Concours d'Elegance & Autocross). The point distribution ensures that the winner will have to participate in both events and encourages event volunteerism.

The rules are:

- 1. You must be a PCA-SAR member.
- 2. You must enter a Porsche in a judged Concours d'Elegance Class (Wash and Shine or higher) and/or Autocross.
- 3. You may enter more than one Porsche. Concours d'Elegance score will be from the car with the highest total points or vehicle designated by participant.
- 4. Volunteer Participation Bonus Points (Volunteering at any of the four events: Concours d'Elegance, Autocross, Golf Tournament, Rally) will be awarded by the Cinco de Mayo Committee.
- 5. The Cinco de Mayo Autocross Chair and Logistics Coordinator will determine Autocross scores.
- 6. Scoring will be determined from the table below.
- 7. Cinco de Mayo Chair or Committee has final interpretation of rules and/or scoring.

Registering for the Concours and Autocross will automatically enter all PCA-SAR members. Final scoring will not take place until after the Concours d'Elegance and Autocross are completed and results are posted on the PCA-SAR website and or Facebook Page. Score sheets will be reviewed at the May board meeting prior to award announcement at the June General Meeting. Winners will be awarded PCA-SAR gift certificate for a future event.

It is not too early to start cleaning your Porsche or to improve your autocross skills. So, remember to register yourself and your favorite Porsche in the Concours d' Elegance and the Autocross. If you have any questions about the Contest, feel free to contact me by email kjkendler@comcast.net.

Dave McCrory Memorial Car Show





From the Orange Coast Region:



RI#	CAST	Turn	Details
10	25	R	At STOP
9		L	At STOP

Make sure you execute RI# 9 (Turn Left at STOP) before you execute RI# 10 (Turn R, Change Average Speed To 25, at STOP)


